

Non-Filer IRS Portal Notice: How to Get Your Stimulus Payment if You Don't File a Tax Return

This is a follow up on our notice regarding stimulus payments for social security payments:

The IRS portal for non-filers is now live. This is **not** the same as the portal for those who file a tax return and want to receive a direct deposit instead of a physical check. Who should use this non-filer portal?

Eligible U.S. citizens or permanent residents who:

- Had gross income that did not exceed \$12,200 (\$24,400 for married couples) for 2019
- Were not otherwise required to file a federal income tax return for 2019, and didn't plan to

This is especially useful for those of you who receive Social Security as your only source of income. The link to this portal can be found below and is clickable. The link will direct you to the official IRS website page for non-filers and will tell you everything you need to know.
