

IRS Web Portal for Stimulus Payments is Now Live

Most people who are registered for direct deposit should have received their stimulus payment today. Didn't get yours yet? No worries, we didn't get ours yet either. One reason you may have not gotten your payment is because you may not be set up for direct deposit. Checks will come in the mail but expect them to be delayed compared to a direct deposit payment. Luckily, the IRS web portal is now live through this link:

You can use this link to check your payment status, confirm your payment type (direct deposit or check), and/or to enter your bank account information for direct deposit. If you are expecting a check, you can register for direct deposit here for an expediated delivery of your payment.

This is the first day the site has been live, so do not fret if you experience some technical difficulties or long wait times. You will need to provide your Social Security number, DOB, address and bank account information (routing number and account number). You will also need your most recent tax return (2019 or 2018) handy to confirm a few things. This whole process should only take about 5 minutes once you are in the portal. To locate specific information on your tax return, you can hover over the question mark icons in the portal to get the exact line numbers you need to look at.
